- FGP 15/23 To receive apologies and reasons for absence**

The Redbourne Mere pothole had still not been resurfaced despite the fact that the Clerk was assured on the 2<sup>nd</sup> February that it would be inspected within 4 days. The Clerk would again chase this up. The bins, dog bins and noticeboards should all be delivered within the next month.

There had been three burials this month. One of the memorial masons had left tyre marks on the grass which the Clerk had contacted them about. The grave levelling was still ongoing.

The change of route to the Klipper was being discussed, it had been agreed to take Redbourne, Hibaldstow and Gainsthorpe off the route, a new timetable was currently being produced, NLC had not agreed to an extension of the route down to Woodpecker and Bader Way but they were able to accommodate an extension of the route to the garden centre. The new route should be in place a week or two after Easter following the notice period for change of route. The Call Connect Service would be launched this week.
