The grounds maintenance contractors had replaced some of the winter bedding plants as they had failed due to damp weather. All else in hand.

60.1 To consider waiving a cemetery fee for special circumstances

The Clerk explained the situation in that the burial was particularly sensitive, but that she had informed the funeral director of the fee at the time of booking the interment and no request had been made to waive the fee, the funeral director had simply not paid despite several polite reminders. The funeral directors were now saying that the church had agreed to pay the fee directly to the council. The council understood that the situation was difficult but all fees need to be accounted for for audit purposes and the council were not prepared to set a precedent, especially given that no discussion had taken place at the of booking the interment. It was **resolved** not to waive the fee, and to put the decision in writing to the funeral director, also reminding them that the council's contract is with themselves, not with the church, and any agreement they make regarding fees with the church is a separate and private arrangement..
